

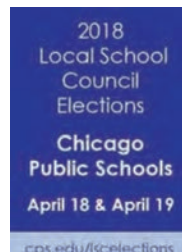

LSC Elections

The 2018 local school council elections will take place on Wednesday, April 18, 2018 for elementary schools and Thursday, April 19, 2018 for high schools. The following individuals are eligible to vote in a school's election for parent and community representatives:

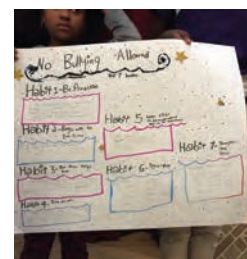


- Parents, legal guardians and temporary custodians of students enrolled in the school
- Persons at least 18 years old who reside within the school's attendance area or voting district.
