Medicaid is free or low cost health insurance provided to those who qualify. Covered services include doctor visits, vaccines, prescriptions and more.

### Two Ways CPS can Help You Enroll in Medicaid:

1. A Contact the Medicaid Designee at your child's school to schedule an enrollment appointment. Call your school or call (773) 553-KIDS (5437) to determine who is the Medicaid Designee.
