II. Recap of Events

Sports Banquet - Michelle

- · Really great event, first time ever, will be held annually going forward
- All kids recognized and received rewards who participated in any CPS / Peirce sport this school year
- Budget paid for from the school budget

New Family Open House - Michelle

- Good turnout, about 40 50 people in total. All attendees took a tour of the school.
- Very welcoming

Teacher Year-End Gifting - Helena

- We have about \$12k collected so far. This is on par with what we collected this time last year
- \$55 left from December gifting, which we will put toward year-end gifting.
- \$1745 left from Teacher Appreciation collected earlier this year. We agreed we will keep this in our budget for the fall appreciation breakfast / luncheons.
- Gift money being collected right now should be 100% for the year-end teacher gifts.
- For next year, we propose combining Teacher Appreciation gifting with year-end gifting so we're not asking for funds from families twice, so closely in the same part of the year.
- Next year we also want to be more inclusive about including all staff in Teacher Appreciation Week, and call it Teacher and Staff Appreciation Week
- Michelle is also going to talk to FOP about perhaps moving Move-a-thon to the fall, to get families excited at the beginning of the year, as this donation collection can impact families' ability to donate to so many events.
